In this nightmarish universe, nothing is what it seems, setting up an ambiguous, darkly nihilistic-- yet intriguing--conclusion.

The film was written and directed by Tomaselli. The DVD will feature a variety of extras, including an audio commentary by Tomaselli; behind-the-scenes footage; still gallery; and an anamorphic widescreen transfer.

Elite Entertainment was founded in 1993.
